


Eckert Fine Art

Eckert's expertise and passion for this period, cultivated through her early years writing and lecturing in the Midwest, has been the driving force behind the gallery's success.

Eckert Fine Art's new location on the campus of MASS MoCA showcases works by renowned Post-War and Contemporary artists such as Robert Rauschenberg, Christo, John Chamberlain, Julian Stanczyk, Robert Indiana, James Rosenquist, Sol LeWitt, James Turrell, Don Gummer, Hunt Slonem, Chizuru Morii Kaplan, and Robert Cottingham. The gallery is also the exclusive representative of Realist painter Eric Forstmann.

Throughout its history, Eckert Fine Art has placed significant works by Roy Lichtenstein, Henry Moore, Giorgio de Chirico, Niki de Saint Phalle, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Thomas Hart Benton, and George Bellows in prestigious museums and private collections worldwide, solidifying its position as a leading authority in the art world.


