# Spotlight on New York: Returning and New Galleries at Art Palm Beach 2025

Art Palm Beach 2025, scheduled for January 22-26 at the Palm Beach County Convention Center, continues to expand its roster of international galleries. This month, we highlight three exhibitors with a focus on New York, among other locations.

Hollis Taggart and Modern Fine Art, both based in New York, are returning exhibitors from Art Palm Beach 2024. Hollis Taggart specializes in historical and contemporary American art, while Modern Fine Art, with an additional location in London, offers a curated selection of 20th and 21st century works. Joining Art Palm Beach as a new exhibitor for 2025 is Sundaram Tagore Gallery, with locations in New York, Singapore, and London. Sundaram Tagore Gallery focuses on cross-cultural contemporary art.

## Gallery Highlights

### Hollis Taggart, New York

Founded in 1979, Hollis Taggart has been a cornerstone in the American art scene for over four decades. The gallery's mission is to present museum-quality works of art, maintain a program driven by scholarship, and offer personalized support in all aspects of art collecting.

Hollis Taggart's expertise spans from the Hudson River School to American Modernism and Post-War and Contemporary movements. The gallery has collaborated with leading scholars to produce critically acclaimed shows and scholarly catalogues, sponsoring four catalogue raisonné projects, including those of Daniel Garber and Kay Sage.



Hollis Taggart represents an impressive roster of artists, including Josef Albers, Alexander Calder, Willem de Kooning, Helen Frankenthaler, Yayoi Kusama, Joan Mitchell, and Andy Warhol, among many others. The gallery continues to advise private collectors, corporations, and museums on acquisitions and provides appraisal services.

For Art Palm Beach 2025, Hollis Taggart will present a special highlight from celebrated American artist Joan Mitchell. Mitchell (1925-1992) was a central figure in the second generation of Abstract Expressionism, known for her mastery of color and gestural brushwork. Her art has been exhibited in major institutions worldwide, including the Whitney Museum of American Art and the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris, cementing her status as one of the most influential artists of the 20th century.

## Sundaram Tagore Gallery, New York, Singapore and London

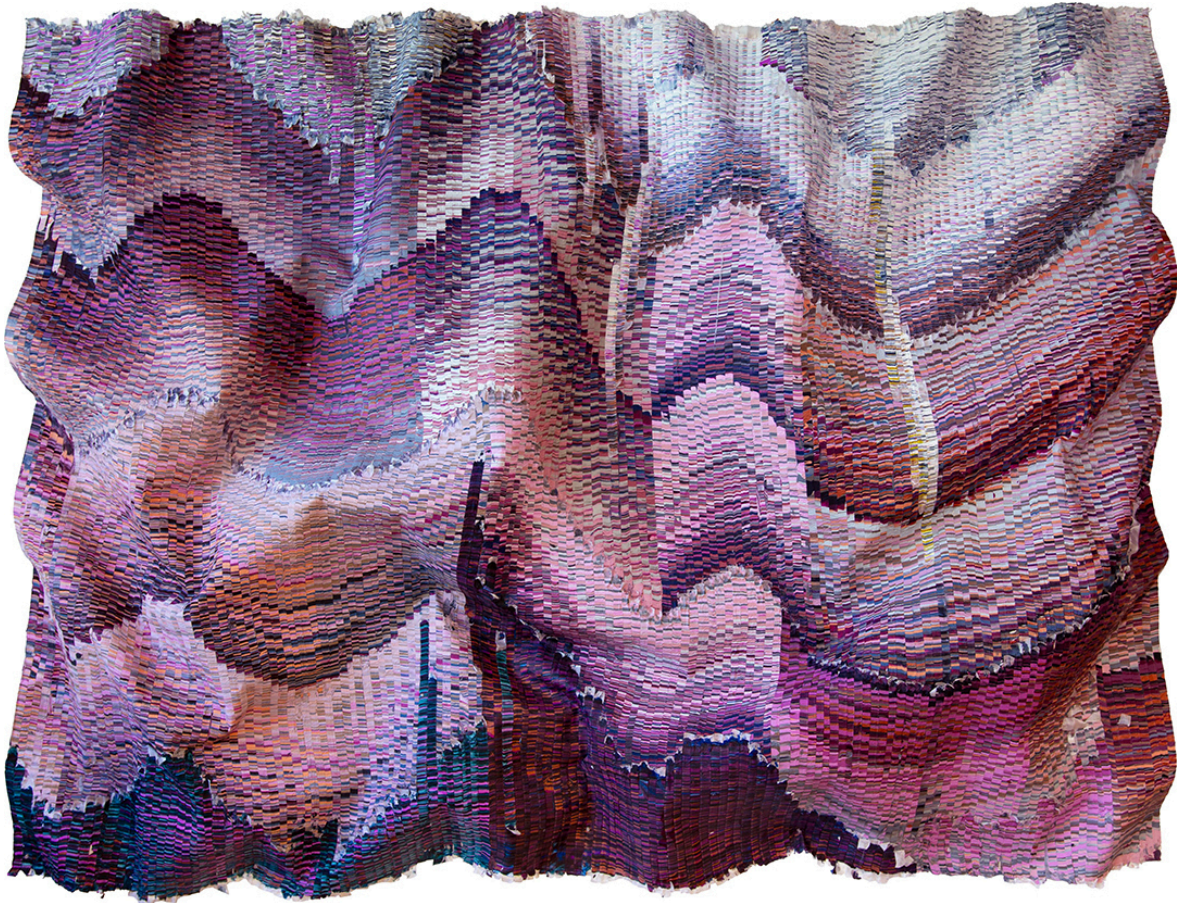
Sundaram Tagore Gallery, founded in 2000, is a contemporary art gallery with a global vision. Originating in New York's SoHo, the gallery has expanded to include locations in Singapore, and most recently, London in 2023.

The gallery's mission, established by founder Sundaram Tagore, is to showcase artists who transcend cultural and national boundaries. Specializing in aesthetically and intellectually rigorous work, Sundaram Tagore Gallery represents artists producing museum-calibre paintings, drawings, sculptures, and installations with a strong emphasis on materiality. The gallery also features a robust photography program including some of the world's most noted photographers.

Sundaram Tagore Gallery is known for challenging prevailing narratives, championing artists from diverse backgrounds, particularly women and those from underrepresented cultures. The gallery's roster synthesizes Western visual language with forms, techniques, and philosophies from Asia, the Subcontinent, and the Middle East.

For Art Palm Beach 2025, Sundaram Tagore Gallery will present works by acclaimed artists Hiroshi Senju, Miya Ando, and Kenny Nguyen. This selection exemplifies the gallery's commitment to cross-cultural artistic exploration and materiality in contemporary art.

## Modern Fine Art, New York

Modern Fine Art, established in 2023 by Ray Waterhouse, brings over four decades of art market expertise to 20th and 21st century art dealing. Located on New York's Upper East Side with an office in London, the gallery specializes in Impressionist, Modern, Post-War, and Contemporary art.



For Art Palm Beach 2025, Modern Fine Art will present a world premiere solo exhibition of sculptures by Mark Eisen. This exclusive showcase will feature six mirror-polished stainless-steel sculptures, marking the first public exhibition of Eisen's work. The artist, who passed away in 2023, spent the last decade of his life creating this collection, emphasizing pure shapes and silhouettes.

Born in Cape Town, South Africa in 1958, Eisen had a successful career in fashion design before turning to fine art. His sculptures embody his unique principles, exploring material transformation, the emotional impact of color, and the interplay of reflectivity, concavity, and convexity.

Ray Waterhouse, founder of Modern Fine Art, notes, "We believe that Mark Eisen's extraordinary wall sculptures will receive an overwhelmingly positive response from the art-buying public. The designs are both simple and complex and are supremely well made - the highly reflective finish of the works invites the viewer to become part of the artworks."

This world premiere at Art Palm Beach 2025 offers collectors a unique opportunity to acquire Eisen's works at their launch price, marking a significant moment in the artist's posthumous career.

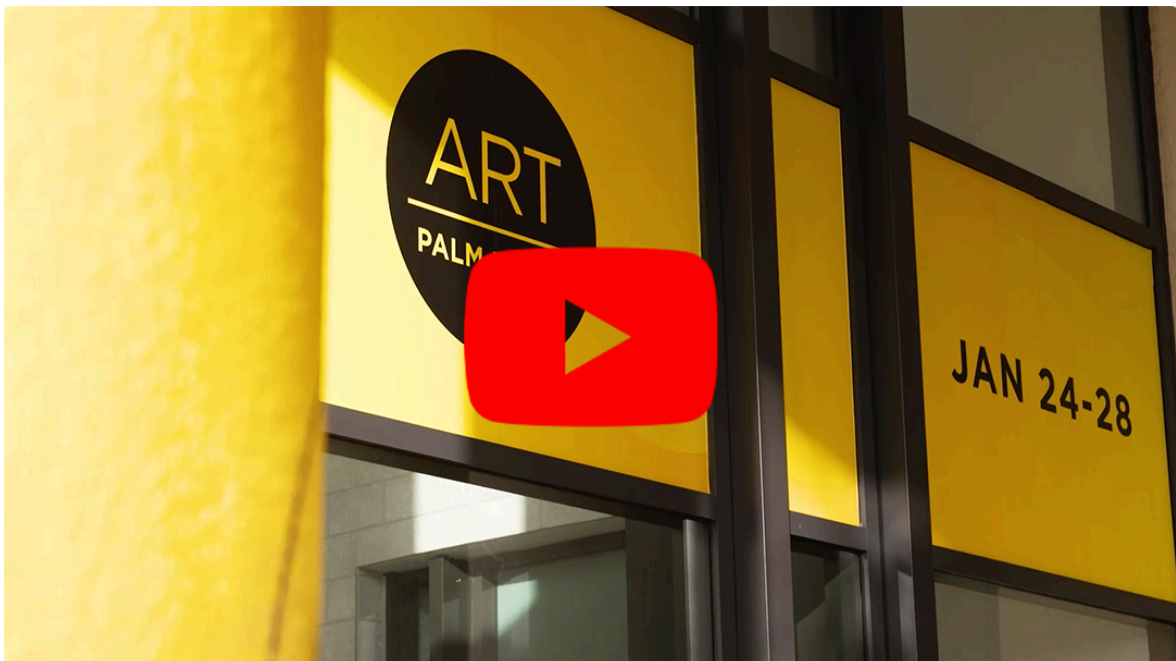

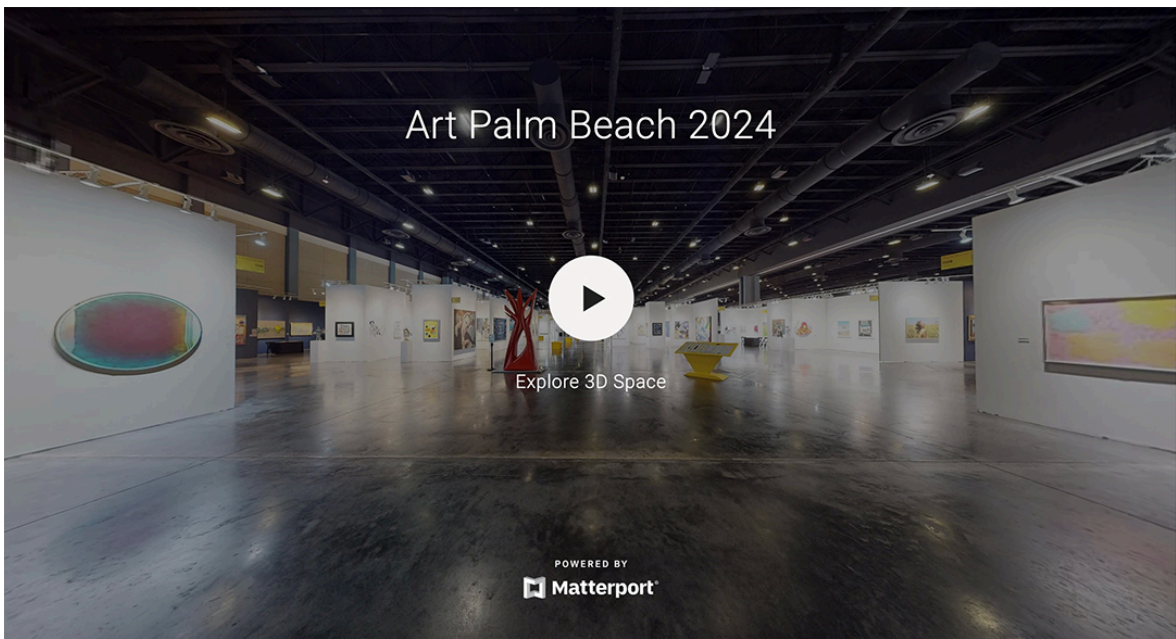
