### Spotlight on New Galleries at Art Palm Beach 2025

With just one month to go, Art Palm Beach is gearing up for its 2025 edition, January 22–26, at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. As the first major art show of the year, it sets the stage for an exciting season of artistic discovery.

## 2025 Gallery Highlights

## Rosenbaum Contemporary, Boca Raton & Palm Beach

Founded in 1979 by Marvin and Howard Rosenbaum, and later joined by Lara Rosenbaum, Rosenbaum Contemporary has established itself as a premier fine art gallery in South Florida. With locations in Boca Raton and Palm Beach, the gallery is renowned for its museum-level exhibition program featuring Postwar, Modern, and Contemporary masters.

Rosenbaum Contemporary's carefully curated inventory spans a diverse range of mediums, including paintings, photographs, sculptures, works on paper, and mixed media pieces. The gallery represents an impressive roster of internationally acclaimed artists such as Bill Beckley, Fernando Botero, Alexander Calder, Jim Dine, Jean Dubuffet, Sam Francis, Robert Indiana, Alex Katz, Roberto Matta, Frank Stella, Manolo Valdes, and Tom Wesselmann.

## Galerie Raphael, Frankfurt

Established in 1981 by Petru Petrov, Galerie Raphael has become a cornerstone of Frankfurt's art scene, specializing in Modern, Post-War & Contemporary prints and works on paper. The gallery's journey began with an exhibition by Romanian painter Horia Damian, setting the stage for four decades of artistic exploration.

Now led by Raphael Petrov, the gallery has hosted over 220 themed and solo exhibitions, featuring works by renowned artists such as Francis Bacon, Marc Chagall, Robert Longo, Henri Matisse, Takashi Murakami, and Pablo Picasso. Galerie Raphael has also published more than 100 sole prints and portfolios by gallery artists, cementing its role in nurturing contemporary artistic expression.

At Art Palm Beach 2025, Galerie Raphael will present notable pieces including Alex Katz's 1993 screenprint "Pas de Deux," Sam Francis's 1977 color monotype "A Fixed course of change #6," and Pablo Picasso's 1972 aquatint etching "Verre d'absinthe." This selection exemplifies the gallery's commitment to diverse print media and significant 20th-century artists.

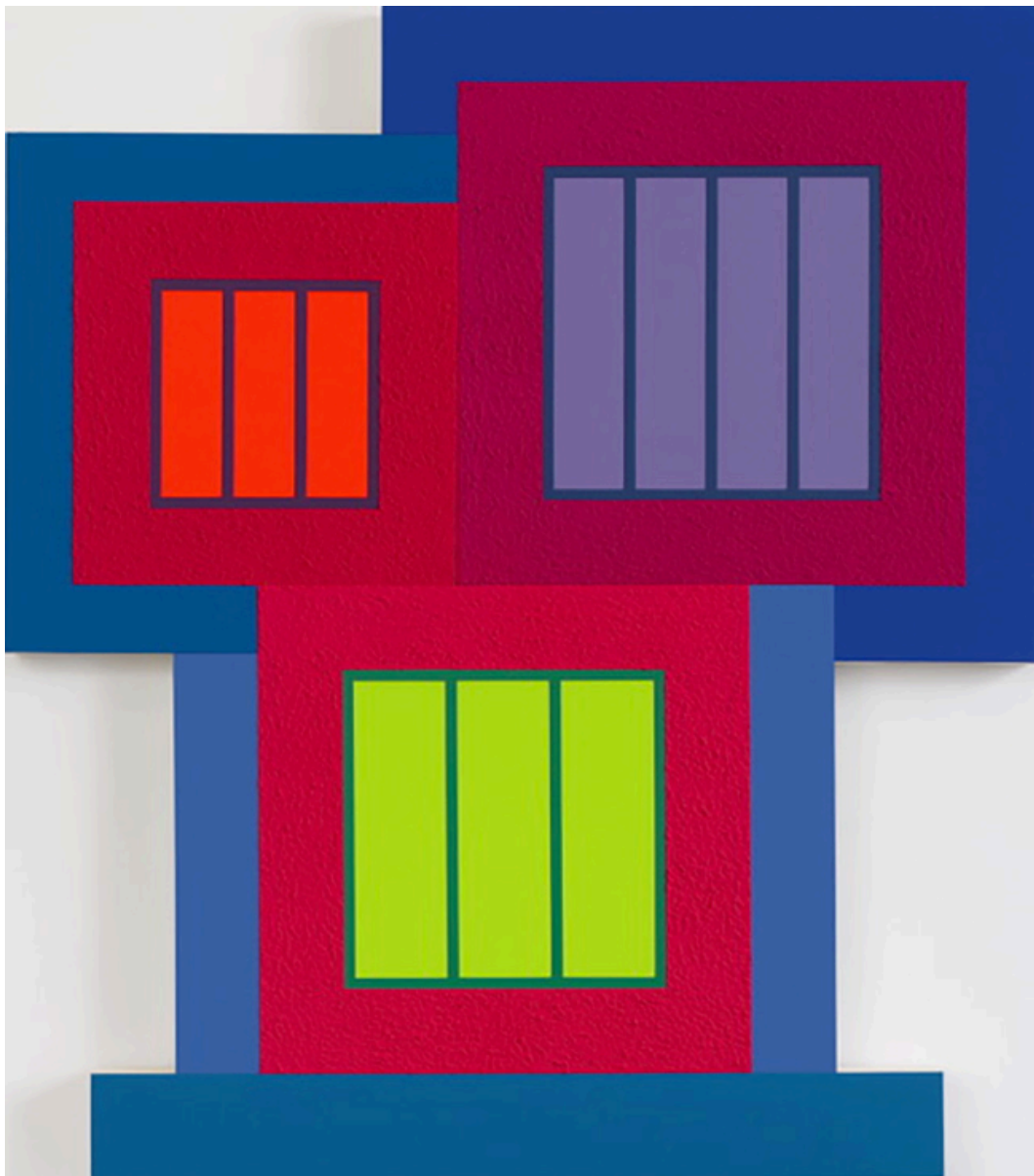
## Galería Cortina, Barcelona

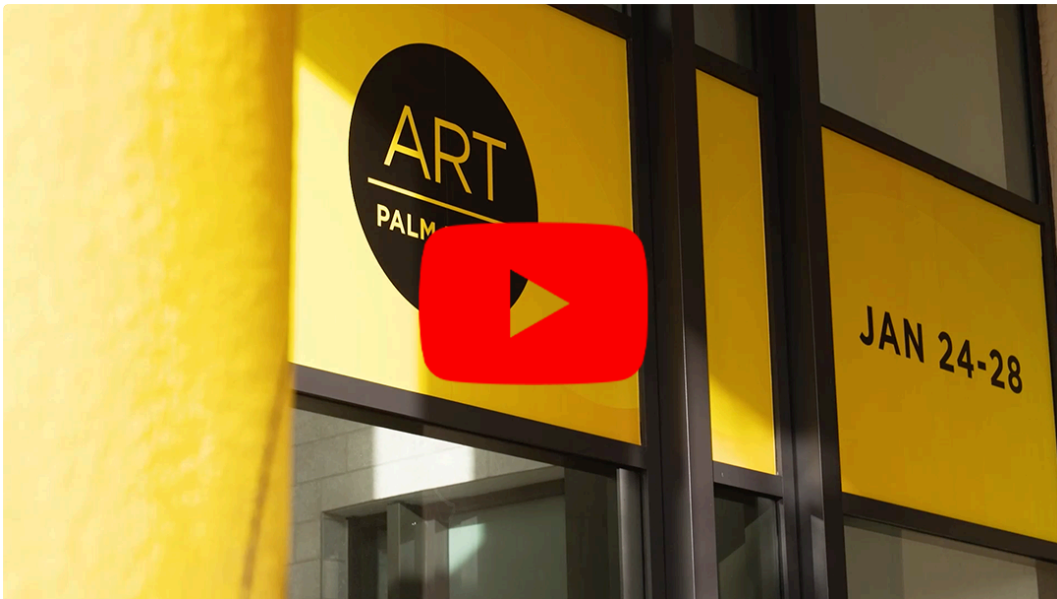

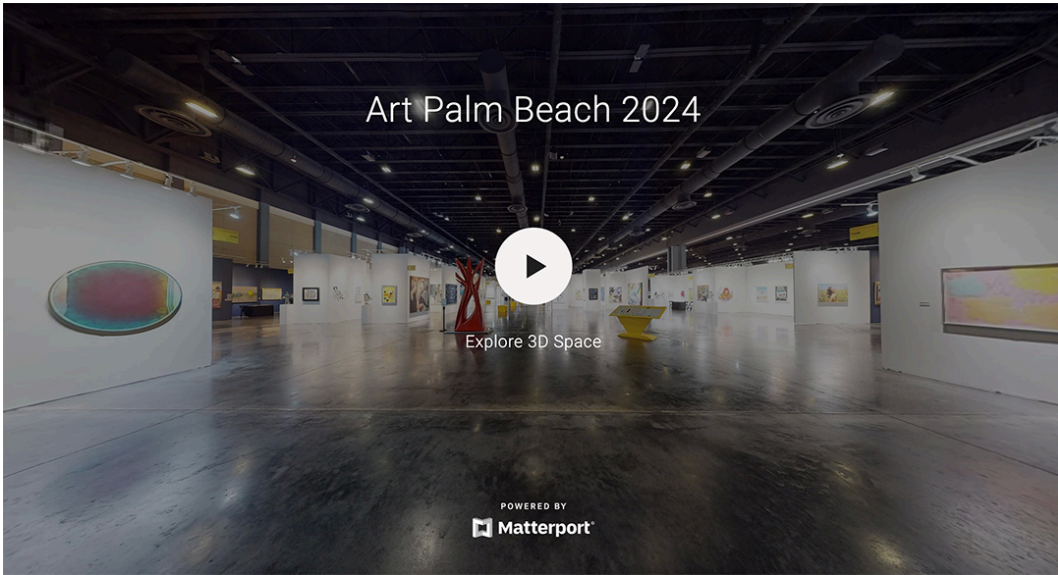
